

MONTEREY COUNTY FILM COMMISSION'S DIRECTOR EMERITUS RICHARD TYLER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

2019 APPLICATION

2019 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Monterey County Film Commission student scholarship award program was created to provide financial aid and incentive to students of film and beginning filmmakers. The goal of the scholarship award is to provide, encourage and support educational opportunities relating to film, to the residents of Monterey County. This scholarship award is named to honor of one of our longest serving Board members, Richard Tyler. The purpose of MCFC's Director Emeritus Richard Tyler Scholarship Award, a permanent endowment at the Community Foundation for Monterey County, is to keep a growing amount of funds available in perpetuity and annually make awards to deserving filmmakers and students of film.

The MCFC Scholarship Award Selection Committee will consist of seven (7) members: four (4) members of the MCFC Scholarship Award Committee and three (3) local film professionals. The selection committee, the board of directors, and employees of the Monterey County Film Commission, scholarship sponsors, as well as family members of the aforementioned shall be ineligible for the Scholarship Award. Applicants may not have been affiliated in any capacity with the MCFC for at least six months prior to their application.

All completed applications must be postmarked by Wednesday, April 17, 2019 or received in our office by 5 P.M. The recipient(s) of the award of \$2,000 or two (2) \$1,000 awards will be announced and notified no later than Friday, May 10, 2019. Recipient(s) will receive a letter of instruction on how to claim their Scholarship Award and will have six (6) months after notification, to complete the claim process. If the Scholarship Award is not claimed within the six (6) month period, the award will be forfeited and the funds will be returned to the MCFC's Director Emeritus Richard Tyler Scholarship Award fund.

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2019 APPLICATION

All materials must be submitted or postmarked by **Wednesday, April 17, 2019**. No applications will be accepted after this deadline date. Incomplete application packets and applications without signatures will not be reviewed. Application materials should be submitted on single-sided sheets without staples. **PLEASE NOTE**: Only **ONE** applicant per submission is allowed. No dual or "team" applications will be accepted. No exceptions. Students collaborating on a project may submit applications naming the same project as the "project purpose," but the applications will be considered independent of each other.

Each Applicant Must Fulfill These Criteria:

- 1. Must be currently enrolled <u>for at least 9 units</u> at a Community College, University or accredited post-secondary film school in Monterey County. Application must include official proof of current registration from the Registrar.
- 2. Be age 18 or older. Applicant must include a photocopy of a government-issued photo identification showing date of birth and current address.
- 3. Have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher. Applicant must include a copy of transcript(s) for all prior college-level work (unofficial copies are acceptable).
- 4. Provide two (2) "Applicant Assessment" forms from two (2) different people familiar with the applicant's work. These should be from faculty, staff or employers familiar with the application's work. Assessments from family, student collaborators, and/or friends will not be given full consideration.
- 5. Write a Statement of Project Purpose (250 words or less) showing strong commitment to specific goals as a filmmaker.
- 6. Write a Statement of Financial Need (250 words or less) documenting financial details (i.e. dollar amounts/estimates for fees, equipment, software, travel, etc.) and explaining specifically how the scholarship money will be used.
- 7. Write a Statement of Prior Film-Related Project(s) (500 words or less) on which the applicant worked. Statement should explain the applicant's specific area(s) of responsibility, his/her impact on the project(s) overall, and if applicable, how that experience relates to and/or inspires your proposed Project Purpose.

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by mail. The MCFC Scholarship Award Committee reserves the right and sole authority to select students and filmmakers based on their individual merits, financial need, and the consensus of the Committee. The top two or three finalists will be invited to interview with the Committee to pitch their project and to complete the selection process.

Attach a 250-word (or less) **Statement of Financial Need** describing in detail your financial need. Explain specifically how you intend to use the scholarship funds and how it relates specifically to the Project Purpose. Provide dollars amounts/estimates for equipment, fees, travel, etc.

Section 4

Attach a 500-word (or less) **Statement of Prior Film-Related Project(s)** describing your involvement. Explain your specific area(s) of responsibility, how you contributed to the success of the project(s), and if applicable, how that experience relates to and/or inspires your proposed Project Purpose.

Section 5

Attach two (2) "Applicant Assessment" forms from two (2) individuals familiar with you and your work and/or abilities.

Section 6

Attach a copy of transcripts for ALL prior college-level work (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).

Section 7

Attach a copy of current California Driver's License or other government-issued photo identification that also shows your current address.

Section 8

Also include official proof of <u>current</u> registration at a Community College or University from the Office of the Registrar.

Section 9

Read the statement below, sign and date this form, and return the completed application packet to the address listed on the first page of this Application Form.
