Monterey County Film Commission elects new officers and adds Dot Findlater to Board of Directors

(Monterey, CA) --The nonprofit Monterey County Film Commission's board of directors has elected its officers for the next fiscal year, and also appointed Dot Findlater of Monterey to serve a three-year term as board director.

The new president is Paula Joy MacNab, a realtor with David Lyng Real Estate. Other officers are Paul Ventura, vice president; Jeff Clark, secretary; Camille Stanfield Polson, treasurer; and Julia Avery-Rudey, president emeritus. Board members Pete Bassett and Garland Thompson were re-elected to serve three-year terms.

Newest board member Findlater is the founder and CEO of Mirror Images Global Entertainment LLC, an agency and talent management firm for professional celebrity look-alikes, who has managed and developed talent for film and TV production statewide and in Europe for more than 27 years.
